Proposed call time will be 8:30 a.m. on October 20, 2016

Today, October 20, 2016, at 9:00 a.m., Archbold Memorial Hospital will be conducting an emergency preparedness exercise. This exercise will involve law enforcement and other first responders. There will be street closures around the hospital and Jerger Elementary, preventing entrance to or exiting of the Jerger campus.
